Round/Format

Saturday 10 August (Tier 2+):

- WA 1440. Compounds and recurves will shoot on individual six zone 80cm faces at 50 and 30m. Barebows and longbows will shoot on a full single 80cm face at both 50m and 30m.

Sunday 11 August (Tier 1):

- WA 70m & 50m round followed by WRS head-to-head eliminations in the afternoon.
- A cut will be made to the top 64 in each discipline

Entry Information

Fee: £55

- There are no single day entries available. National Tour points are awarded only to those who shoot both days.
- No refunds 28 days prior to the competition date.
- All entries will be treated in accordance with the Archery GB privacy notice.

Priority entry and invitation

Monday 8 April:

- Top 30 2023 ranked compound & recurve
- Top 10 in the 2023 National longbow rankings
- Top 16 barebow from the 2023 National rankings

Open entry to all members: 11 April at 7 pm

Event timings

Registration and equipment inspection from 7:30am, practice ends to start at 8:30am. There will be no practice on Friday night.

Prizes

- National Trophies and the Championship Title will be awarded to the highest placed British Archery GB member. After the presentation, all trophies must be returned to the Competition Organiser.
- Distance awards will be available.
