## Featuring new hall and target lighting!

### Round/Format

- All archers will shoot on a 3-spot face, have a ten second lead in and 90 seconds to shoot all three arrows.
- Groups of six archers will shoot 12-arrow head-to-head matches against each other, gaining two points for a win, or one point for a draw. This forms a ranking table within each group.
- The top two from each group will move to stage two. Across all the groups, the highest scorers will also go through (the number will depend on the amount of people there are in total).
- In stage two, the top two from each group will proceed to the final six archers. This will be based on highest total of match wins.
- The final six proceed into a shoot down to decide the winner.

- All entries will be treated in accordance with the Archery GB privacy notice.


