Round/Format

Saturday August (Tier 2+):

- WA 1440. Compounds and recurves will shoot on individual six zone 80cm faces at 50 and 30m. Barebows and longbows will shoot on a full single 80cm face at both 50m and 30m
- Six arrows to be shot in four minute ends
- This results from this day will also serve as the English Championships for recurve, compound & barebow

Sunday August (Tier 1):

- WA 70m & 50m round followed by WRS head-to-head eliminations in the afternoon
- Six arrows to be shot in 3 minute ends. For the head-to-heads, three arrows will be shot in 90 seconds
- This round is the official World Archery National event in the UK to obtain minimum qualifying scores to participate in the 2026 World Cup circuit

Entry Information

Fee: £57.50

- There are no single day entries available.
- National Tour points are awarded only to those who complete both days.
- No refunds 28 days prior to the competition date.
- All entries will be treated in accordance with the Archery GB privacy notice.

Priority entry and invitation

Monday 5 May:

- Top 30 2024 ranked compound & recurve
- Top 10 in the 2024 National longbow rankings
- Top 24 barebow men and top 16 barebow women from the 2024 National rankings

Event timings

Registration and equipment inspection from 7:30am, practice ends to start at 8:30am. There will be no practice on Friday night.

Prizes

- National Trophies and the Championship title will be awarded to the highest placed British Archery GB member across the combination of all three events (WA 70/50m, WA 1440, and the National Tour results).
- The National Tour rankings are awarded based on an accumulation of a person's scores from day one and day two. National Tour points therefore are only awarded to those who complete both days.
- After the presentation, all trophies must be returned to the Competition Organiser.
- Distance awards will be available.
