- UK record status Portsmouth
- Recurve, barebow, longbow archers and compound archers in the U12 and U14 categories in all age categories will shoot on 60cm full faces. Compound archers in the U15, U16, U18 and U21 categories will shoot on 3-spot faces.
- Age groups listed below will be separated into Open and Women's categories.

Entry Information

Fee: £35

- 80% refund up to 29 days before the event start date.
- No refunds 28 days prior to the competition date.
- All entries will be treated in accordance with the Archery GB privacy notice.

- Foyer: 7am
- Hall 2: 7:15am

Event Timings

- Each session will start with two ends of practice
- Session A - archers Under 15, Under 14, and Under 12: 8am

- Session B - all age groups: 11:30am
- **Awards** for Under 15, Under 14, and Under 12 will be after Session B, along with Home Nation awards
- Session C - archers under 16, under 18 and under 21: 3pm
- **Awards** for Under 16, Under 18, and Under 21 will be after Session C

- The winners in each age category will be named the National Champions.
