





Hosting Archery GB Competitions 2025

Applications are invited from clubs, counties, regions, or associations to host the below Archery GB competitions in 2025. Competition hosting requirements are outlined in this document.

All competitions must fit within the 2025 calendar on the nominated weekends:

The format of the competitions is to be in line with the existing event prospectus, and UKRS/WRS must be applied for by the host club where necessary.

- Entries are to be managed on Archery GB's membership competition entry portal (more info available upon request).
 - All entries will be subject to the Archery GB terms and conditions, which must be followed for cancellations or changes.
- The event logo must appear on the entry prospectus.
- All opening dates must be agreed with the Events Manager and will be published on the Archery GB website in advance.
 - From experience, we recommend that entry is open four months prior to the competition.
- It is mandatory that the competitions are scored on lanseo software, so that full and immediate results and standings are live on the internet.
 - \circ $\;$ AGB will provide Ianseo training courses for the host clubs

- Archery GB will appoint some/all the judges for all the above championships.
 - Judges for the Junior Archery Series events are the responsibility of the host club to organise.
- There should be an effective public-address system, and we would like you to play music while archers collect their arrows from the targets.
- The use of A-Frame stands is not permissible at these events. All frames must be H frame style. It is preferred that foam targets are used if possible.
- Archery GB will provide event branding to the host that must be displayed at the venue as required.
- An area for Archery GB sponsors is to be provided if they wish to come and have a trade stand.
- Organisers are encouraged to seek local publicity and sponsorship of your competition.
- The Archery GB competitions team can provide the following equipment and services towards the event. there is a hire charge for some of these services.
- Event entry and results system:
 - Management of entries and waiting lists on Sport 80
 - Target list allocation to your specification
 - Set up of all Ianseo files, including online
 - Back numbers prepared (club to provide card or tear proof paper & pins)
- Below come at extra charge.
 - Provision of a results team leader for the weekend
 - Delivery of a full results service
 - Supply of the AGB score system (PDAs)
- Field equipment: van hire required.
 - Supply of the AGB flip boards
 - Loan of target nappies if required
 - Loan of a sound system
 - Loan of a Danage timing system
