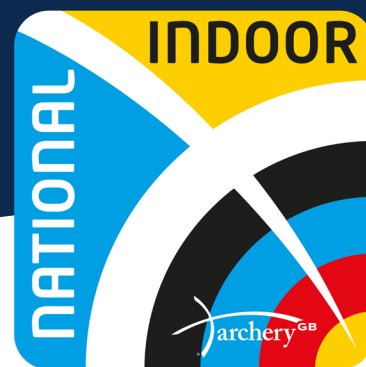


National Indoor Championships 2025 and Home Nations Teams

There will be additional awards for the best qualification score.

Round/Format

- WRS WA 18m ranking round.
- Compound and recurve archers will shoot on 3-spot 40cm faces, and barebow and longbow archers will shoot on 40cm full faces.
- The 50+ category is for compound, recurve and barebow bowstyles only. **If you wish to shoot in the 50+ category, you must state so when you enter.**
- Head-to-heads will be shot in the afternoon of Saturday 6 December, after Sessions B and C.
- The cut for progression onto the head-to-heads will depend on the number of entries. For a bracket to take place, it must be full.
- Numbers for cuts will be indicated prior to the event.

Entry Information

Fee: £43

- Only 1 session per entrant is allowed
- 80% refund up to 29 days before the event start date. No refunds 28 days prior to the competition date.
- All entries will be treated in accordance with the Archery GB privacy notice

Prizes

- The winners in each division will be named the National Champion.

- Hall 2: 2:15pm on Friday 5 December

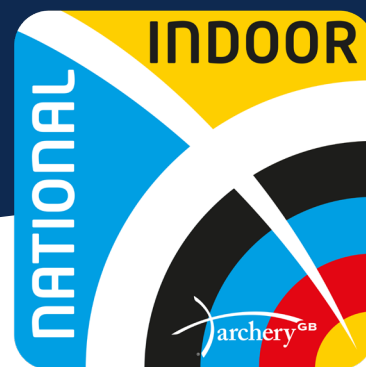
Event Timings

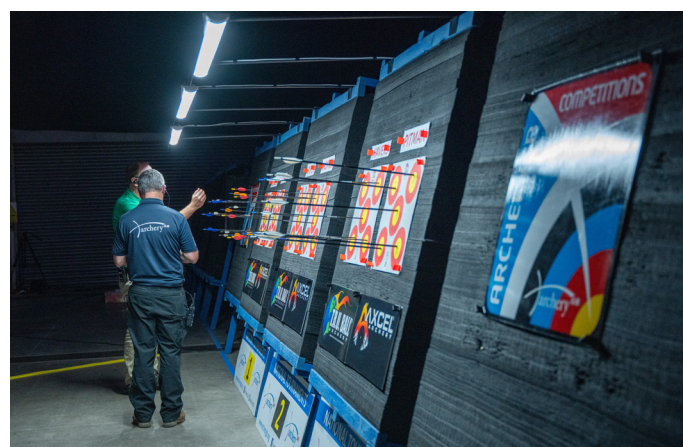
- Featuring our brand new target lights and improved hall lighting.
