High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Balfour Beatty VINCI (BBV) is working in partnership with HS2 Ltd to build the new high speed railway in your area.

The work we will be doing

We are progressing works on the construction for the realignment of B4113 Stoneleigh Road. In preparation for the phased works starting in 2026, we will need to do some utilities investigatory works along the carriageway. To carry out the works in a safe and secure environment, we will need a daytime road closure with temporary traffic lights.

When will these works be taking place

The works on B4113 Stoneleigh Road will be in place from **Monday 1 December until Saturday 13 December 2025**. The road will be closed **Monday to Friday, from 9.30am to 3.30pm** and on **Saturdays from 7am to 2pm**. Outside of the closure times, the road will be open and managed with temporary traffic lights.

What to expect

Access to properties, and for cyclists and pedestrians will be maintained throughout the works. You may notice increased levels of construction activity and some travel disruption. There will be a fully signed diversion in place to help drivers navigate their way. Please see the map on page two.

Please note that access to Stoneleigh Park will only be possible from the Stoneleigh village side.

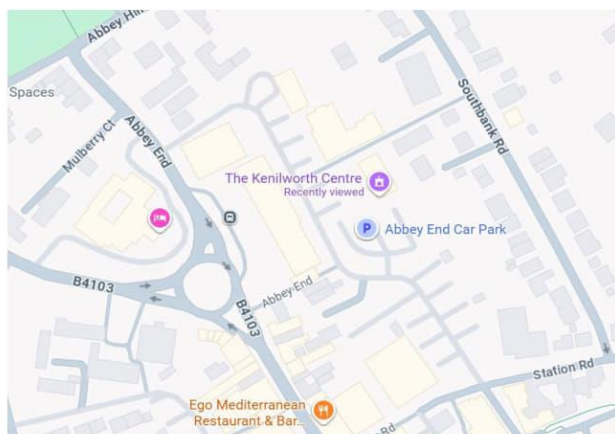
