Round/Format

National Tour and Tier 1 rankings

Saturday:

A single world record status WA 70 round for recurve, with 30 seconds per arrow timing (this means you will have a total of 180 seconds to shoot 6 arrows). Followed by head-to-head eliminations. The cut will be for the top 64.

On Saturday, there will be a 60m round available for U18 recurve archers which they can request upon entry. Please note, the archers in this category will not be eligible for prize money, and they will not be included in the National Tour stage results.

Sunday:

A single world record status WA 50 round for compound and barebow, with 30 seconds per arrow timing (this means you will have a total of 180 seconds to shoot 6 arrows). Followed by head-to-head eliminations. The cut will be for the top 64.

Entry fee

Recurve Saturday: £35, and £25 for U18 recurve archers shooting 60m

Compound and barebow Sunday: £35

Priority entry and invitation

Monday 20 January:

- Top 30 2024 ranked compound & recurve
- Top 24 barebow men and top 16 barebow women from the 2024 National rankings

Event timings

Registration and equipment inspection from 7:30am, 3 practice ends to start at 8:30am. There will be no practice on Friday or Saturday night.
