#### National Tour and Tier 1 rankings Saturday:

A Tier 1 single world record status WA 70 round for recurve, with 30 seconds per arrow timing (this means you will have a total of 180 seconds to shoot 6 arrows). Followed by head-to-head eliminations. The cut will be for the top 64.

## Sunday:

A Tier 1 single world record status WA 50 round for compound and barebow, with 30 seconds per arrow timing (this means you will have a total of 180 seconds to shoot 6 arrows). Followed by headto-head eliminations. The cut will be for the top 64.

## Entry fee

£30 for each day No refunds after 6 June 2025. Refunds do not include admin fees taken by Sport80 and/or Stripe.

- Top 30 2024 ranked compound & recurve
- Top 16 barebow from the 2024 National Tour rankings
