Round/Format

National Tour and Tier 1 rankings

Saturday:

A Tier 1 single world record status WA 70 round for recurve and WA 50 for compound and barebow. 30 seconds per arrow timing (this means you will have a total of 180 seconds to shoot 6 arrows). Followed by head-to-head eliminations.

Sunday:

Tier 2+ world record status WA double 70/50m round. There will be no practice before the start of the second round.

Entry fee

£55 for the weekend. There are no single day purchases.

If you cancel your entry 28 days or more before the event, then you will receive a refund less 20%.

Priority entry and invitation

Monday 14 April:

- Top 30 2024 ranked compound & recurve
- Top 24 barebow men and top 16 barebow women from the 2024 National rankings

- There is no practice on the evening of Friday 18 July or Saturday 19 July
- Gates open at 7:30am
- Registration and equipment inspection at 8:15am
- Assembly at 8:45am, followed by 3 practice ends immediately after

- Music will be played at this event.
- Only assistance/guide dogs are permitted on the archery field.
- Please register with the tournament organisers on the day if you wish to take photos. A registration form will be available to complete outside the DOS tent. Unauthorised photography is not permitted.
- The tournament field overshoot areas have a mixed area of woodland and high banking. They have been given dispensation by AGB for tournament use.
