## Round/format

### National Tour and Tier 1 rankings

This event is open to any archer who has earned EMB, GMB, or MB from January 2024 up until 14 June 2025. Entries will close when the shoot is full.

UK Masters + National Tour Stage 4 Tier 1 ranking event

Saturday 28 June:

- Double WRS 70m & 50m
  - Recurve & Longbow 70m
  - Compound & Barebow 50m
- 3 minutes per end

Sunday 29 June:

- Repêchage head-to-head matches. There will be matches held to shoot for every position. The number of matches required will be dependent on the number of entries in a category. You are **never** knocked out.
- 90 seconds per three arrows

## Entry information

Fee: £55

- There are no single day entries available. National Tour points are awarded only to those who **complete** both days.
- No refunds 28 days prior to the competition date. All entries will be treated in accordance with the Archery GB privacy notice.

## Event timings

- Saturday: Registration and equipment inspection from 7:30am, practice ends to start at 8:30am. There will be no practice on Friday night.
- Sunday: Timings to be published on lanseo in advance of the event. Categories will start at varying times throughout the morning.

## Awards

- The UK Masters Championships will be the overall winner of the head-to-heads.
- There will be score awards available for the Saturday for the highest double 70m/50m and the highest single 70m/50m.
