Round/Format

National Tour and Tier 1 rankings

Saturday:

A Tier 1 single world record status WA 50 round for compound and barebow, with 30 seconds per arrow timing (this means you will have a total of 180 seconds to shoot 6 arrows). Followed by head-to-head eliminations. The cut will be for the top 64.

Sunday:

A Tier 1 single world record status WA 70 round for recurve, with 30 seconds per arrow timing (this means you will have a total of 180 seconds to shoot 6 arrows). Followed by head-to-head eliminations. The cut will be for the top 64.

Entry fee

£35 for each day

Refunds of £30 permitted before 2 May 2026.

Event timings

Assembly at 8:45am followed by 3 practice ends at 9am on both competition days.

Top three places for recurve, compound and barebow; open and women

General

- Tents are permitted and can be put up between 5-7pm only on the day before the competition. Do not pitch over the hatched areas in order to keep access to the field clear. Overnight camping or practice is not permitted.
- Food and drinks: hot and cold drinks, along with a selection of cold food (cakes, pastries, etc), will be available in the clubhouse from 8 am each day. If possible please bring your own cup to reduce the waste. Hot food will not be available.
- Toilets: male, female, and disabled toilets are provided.
- Dogs: are permitted but must be kept on a lead at all times.
- Smoking, including vaping, is only permitted on the other side of the road behind the tent line.
- Music will be played throughout the tournament.
- Car parking: no access until 7:30am each day. Parking adjacent to the Clubhouse is reserved for judges, officials, and disabled archers.
- Limited parking is available within the grounds of the club. Please park where directed by Club Officials on the day. Do not park within hatched areas. When all car parking spaces are full on the Club grounds please park on the road outside the club.
- Please do not leave the Club grounds on foot or by car when shooting is in progress as it can distract the archers. Please wait for a break in shooting to exit the grounds.

- Liability: Meriden Archery Club will not accept responsibility for any loss, damage or injury, however caused, either before, during, or after the event.
- If you shoot from a stool or chair and require to remain on the shooting line, please notify the tournament organiser when booking your entry.
- If you do not wish images of yourself to be used by Meriden Archery Club and Archery GB in reporting and future promotion of the event, please indicate this to the tournament organiser at registration.
- Data will be collected and processed in accordance with the Archery GB Privacy Policy.
