Round/Format

Saturday (Tier 2+):

- WA 1440. Compounds and recurves will shoot on individual six zone 80cm faces at 50m and 30m. Barebows and longbows will shoot on a full single 80cm face at both 50m and 30m
- Six arrows to be shot in four minute ends
- The results from this day will also serve as The English Championships for recurve, compound & barebow

Sunday (Tier 1):

- WA 70m & 50m round followed by WRS head-to-head eliminations in the afternoon
- Six arrows to be shot in 3 minute ends. For the head-to-heads, three arrows will be shot in 90 seconds
- There will be a top 64 cut
