



Tournament Organiser: Badges claim form

In order to process claims, all scoresheets **must** be included with this form.

Competition documentation

This document must be returned to the Archery GB within 21 days of the tournament (preferably by email – see below) and be accompanied by:

- a. One (1) copy of the entry form
- b. One (1) copy of the results (two (2) if sending in by post)
- c. Copies of scoresheets for all records and award claims

If an archer claims more than one award at an event, extra copies of the score sheet would be helpful.

Guidance for completing award claims

When the Tournament Organiser signs the TO's Report, they are stating that the scoresheets for record claims and awards have been checked for accuracy and validity.

It is the TO's responsibility to:

- Ensure that there are sufficient forms, please print/photocopy the claim forms
- For two-day tournaments, ensure the forms are correctly dated for each day

It is the archer's responsibility to:

- Claim awards using the appropriate claim forms
- Check their address on the Membership Portal is correct – Archery GB uses the address on the Membership Portal to send certificates/awards

Please note that:

- WA Star and Target Awards may only be claimed at WRS events
- Archery GB Rose Awards may only be claimed at UKRS, Rose Award events
- WA Arrowhead Awards may only be claimed at Arrowhead status events

World and European record claims

The Tournament Organiser must notify Archery GB of any World or European records, initially, by email **on the first working day following the achievement**. To meet the ratification timescales required by World Archery, the organiser must forward the full details of the claim, original score card and a copy of the results to be received by Archery GB **within 5 days of the tournament date**. It is advisable to keep photocopies of all documents submitted.

UK record claims

UK Records Claims must be sent to the Archery GB within 21 days.
